# **Welcome Back!**

Welcome back - we do hope you had a restful summer break and the start of school routines have slipped seamlessly back into place! We've enjoyed our first week back in school, with staff getting to know their new class and launching the topic through a 'guess the staff member from their baby picture' assembly.

Our whole school topic for the autumn term is 'Windows, mirrors doors' – this will explore PSHE, geography and history elements. The topic will involve children reflecting back on themselves as individuals (mirrors), exploring what's outside our window/local geography (windows) and opening doors to the past/future (doors) with a particular focus on World War 1, the 100 year anniversary and what it meant to Salisbury.

What's new in school for this academic year?

- Fencing we have had new fencing installed around the Year 2/office area to give all Key Stage 1 pupils an outside space for learning and to further improve site security. The trees have been cut back and new grass seeds put down, please keep off this area until the grass has been established.
- Playground our Key Stage 2 playground has been resurfaced to improve drainage and prevent huge puddles of water collecting after a down pour. The netball lines are being repainted soon.
