## **Pupil Premium**

Parents and carers who receive certain benefits may be eligible for either Pupil Premium funding and/or Free School Meals. Pupil Premium funding brings an extra £1,320 per child to the school and can be used to both support your child in their education and towards the cost of school trips and/or uniform. All applications are treated with the utmost confidentiality. If you are in receipt of one of the following benefits and think you may be eligible, please contact the school office; Income support; Employment & support allowance; Job Seekers allowance; Child tax credit (family income less than £16,190); Universal credit; NASS.

We follow direction from the 'Health Protection Agency' who give guidance on the control of infection within schools. Pupil who suffer from diarrhoea and/or vomiting should not return to school for 48 clear hours from the last episode.
