Bike Ability

Wiltshire Council Road Safety, in partnership with the school, is offering cycle training for pupils. It is designed to develop road sense, awareness of traffic and to improve your child's ability to ride safely. In March we will be running two sessions for pupils aged 10 years and over (or 9 if they are in the academic year in which they become 10 – Yr 5 upwards). The training is currently Government grant-funded enabling approximately 10 hours cycling tuition for a charge of £5.00 (to cover admin, badges, booklets and certificates). Letters will be sent home next week. We really encourage our Year 5 and 6 pupils to take up this opportunity, especially if they plan to cycle to secondary school.
